

YA HU XIX: DANCES OF UNIVERSAL PEACE GATHERING

MARCH 9-12, 2017

CAMP ALLEN – NAVASOTA, TEXAS

THIS GATHERING for both new and experienced dancers will be facilitated by dance leaders from Texas and the South Central U.S. The Ya Hu gathering is designed to bring area dancers together in order to make and deepen community connections. Our weekend at beautiful Camp Allen in Navasota will include opportunities to experience Dances of Universal Peace, walking practices, zikr, and deeper dance cycles, as offered by our regional dance leaders. On Sunday morning we will participate in some form of a Service of Universal Worship.

Thursday, March 9 Registration will begin at 5:00 pm. Snacks will be available. No formal session this evening - arrive at your leisure to get settled in and hang out.

Friday, March 10 Morning, afternoon, and evening sessions. Meals will be shared as a group.

Please plan to arrive between 5:00 & 9:00 pm Thursday evening.

On Sunday, we will check out of the cabins by noon.

Camp Allen Conference and Retreat Center is the birthplace of our Texas Ya Hu Dance gatherings. Located in Navasota, Texas, Camp Allen provides easy access from the major cities. We will Dance up at the Conference Center in a room beneath All Saints Chapel. Sleeping and meals will be in three 3-bedroom lakeside cabins that will comfortably accommodate about 25 participants. Sleeping quarters include double and bunk beds. Each cabin offers a fully supplied kitchen, two bathrooms and a living room with a fireplace. 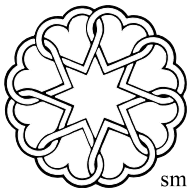

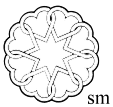

From the beginning of time, sacred movement, song and story have brought people together at times of seasonal ceremony and celebration — as part of everyday life and life passages, in daily renewal and meditation. The Dances of Universal Peace are part of this timeless tradition of Sacred Dance. The Dances are a joyous, multi-cultural way to touch the spiritual essence within ourselves and others. They use sacred phrases, chants, music and movements from the many traditions of the earth to promote peace and integration within individuals and groups. There are no performers or audience: new arrivals and old hands form the circle together. Since their introduction in the late 1960s, the Dances have spread around the earth, touching more than half a million people. Weekly & monthly dance meetings are held in hundreds of cities throughout the world. The Dances of Universal Peace are used in global peace-making & citizen diplomacy, therapy & addiction recovery, education & ecumenical worship celebrations, to name but a few applications.
